



Code of Conduct

What do we do?

We convert waste into valuable raw materials and renewable energy. In doing so, we contribute to the circular economy, the energy transition and combating climate change. Our facilities process waste into new energy and materials, such as in our Energy-from-Waste (EfW) plants, anaerobic digesters, composting plants, and recycling facilities.

Our EfW installations in Moerdijk and Wijster process residual waste into energy. This is sustainable, as half of the energy generated is green, meaning it doesn't require fossil fuels like oil, coal, or gas. As a result, we prevent waste from going to landfill and contribute to a cleaner future.

Attero is a leader in the recovery of raw materials from residual waste. Our facilities separate plastics, drink cartons, metals and food waste, which are then converted into new products and energy. For example, LDPE plastic is processed into new granules, which serve as a raw material for new products.

In addition, Attero converts vegetable, fruit and garden waste (GFT) into green gas and compost, which is used for agriculture, recreational areas and sports fields. Every year, we produce hundreds of thousands of tons of high-quality compost and millions of cubic meters of biomethane, a clean alternative to fossil gas.

We also clean contaminated soil and reduce debris to usable material for construction. This reduces the need to extract natural resources and contributes to the conservation of vulnerable areas.

And for waste streams we want to remove from our environment, our landfills are a safe final destination. Closed landfills are being transformed into recreational areas and solar parks, with which we continue to generate sustainable energy.

Our approach

Safety, sustainability, efficiency and low costs are at the heart of our way of working. Through continuous innovation, we contribute to a clean living environment. Our efforts to reduce CO₂ emissions by replacing fossil energy and new materials ensure that we avoid more emissions than we generate ourselves.

We strive for affordable and efficient processing, recycling and energy generation from waste. We advocate for a level playing field in Europe for waste treatment and the marketing of energy and raw materials.
